

CALL FOR PAPERS

FOWT 2021: 13, 14, 15th April 2021, Brittany
Submission deadline: November 23th, 2020
Official language is English

The submitted papers will be reviewed by FOWT's Scientific and Technical Committee. The selected abstracts will be expected to be translated into PowerPoint presentations lasting no longer than 10-12 minutes.

FOWT 2021's central theme will be: "FOWT: full speed ahead".

Your submissions will need to address the following topics, will need to be original and specifically prepared for FOWT 2021:

1. **From floating array to your home** : the latest on high TRL products, services and solutions contributing to the delivery of commercial-scale floating offshore wind energy to the end-user (from electricity production to distribution, and including H2 and storage solutions)
2. **Transforming environmental concerns into environmental solutions and opportunities** : global experiences showing the successful cohabitation between offshore wind and the environment and/or pre-existing marine activities
3. **Big is beautiful** : the impact of tomorrow's XXL wind turbines on floating offshore wind, from floater design to O&M (technology, harbours, logistics, spatial constraints, etc.)
4. **Higher risks, higher returns ?** why do more and more investors and financial institutions look at floating wind ?
5. **Offshore galore** : how do we ensure the successful offshore installation of dozens of floating structures during one single summer season ?
6. **Targeted innovations** : what are proven concept owners working on to further reduce the cost and increase the reliability of their solutions ?

We encourage and welcome both **highly technical papers** (for our Academic Sessions / Day 3) as well as papers that are more accessible to a **general audience** (Plenary Sessions / Days 1 & 2).

- **The topic at the top of the page so we can save it by reference topic**
- **The title of the presentation (Should be limited to 20 words)**
- **The name(s) of the author(s)**
- **Speaker's name and functions (presentation can only be held in English)**
- **Company / Organisation**
- **Text (between 300 and 400 words / no exceedances permitted)**
- **Contact details : phone number and email**

If your summary is accepted, you will be expected to submit your full presentation using the presentation template which will be provided by the Organization Committee.
